

The Noble Academy Addendum 2016 - 2017

At The Noble Academy, the following clarifying regulations apply to all students, in addition to the Noble Network Student Code of Conduct:

Dress Code:

- Students must wear khaki dress pants or slacks. Students cannot wear khaki colored jeans.
 - Pants cannot have “jean” style pockets with seam visible from the outside.
 - Pants must have a single seam down the pants leg (not a double stitched jean seam).
 - The Dean of Culture reserves the right to deem pants too casual for the professional setting.
- All skirts worn must have belt loops and be at least knee-length.
- No more than one button on The Noble Academy polo may be unbuttoned.
- Any Academy shirt worn must be tucked in at all times. This includes P.E. and athletic uniforms.
- Students must wear school issued shirt, shorts, and/or sweat pants in P.E. class.
- Socks must be plain black, white, gray, or navy. Patterns and designs are not permitted on socks.
- Dress shoes must be all black professional shoes.
 - Black dress shoes cannot be made of canvas, nor have stripes, logos, or lettering present.
 - Moccasins are not permitted.
 - The Dean of Culture reserves the right to deem shoes too casual for the professional setting.
- Students must wear black leather dress belts. Belts cannot have studs or designs and should be solid black without extra holes.
- Distracting jewelry (oversized rings, bracelets, watches, etc.) is not permitted.
- Girls may wear one earring per ear. Earrings should be no larger than a quarter in any direction.
- Only one bracelet or watch per wrist is permitted.
 - Rubber bands with text are not permitted.
- Head accessories should be no larger than 3” in any direction.
- All eyeglasses must be functional and not distracting.
- All contact lenses must be a natural eye color.
- Female students are only permitted to wear one nail color with no designs. Mood change nail polish is not permitted.
- Mohawks, mullets, V cut, or designed cuts are not permitted.

- Hair must be out of student's face, with a professional appearance.
- Female students are not permitted to shave the sides of their hair.
- Un-naturally red dyed hair is not permitted.
- Coats, non-school sweatshirts, or any other outerwear is not permitted to be worn in school and must be taken off before the student passes the designated 'full uniform' threshold.

Other conduct:

- Students must carry their unaltered student ID at all times.
 - Students may wear a school-issued lanyard, upon which only their student ID may be attached.
- School assigned lockers must be closed and locked with no items protruding out.
 - Locks must be on lockers and locked at all times.
- Passing or writing notes during class is not permitted.
- Back packs must always be left in locker and are not permitted in the classroom.
- Electronic devices must always be powered off and left in locker.
- Students are allowed to carry only The Noble Academy drawstring bag to P.E. class.
- Cross-body satchel bags are not permitted.
- "Smacking" teeth or lips and "rolling" eyes is considered disrespectful.
- Students may not chew on any object outside of the lunchroom.
- Standing in front of or within visible range of the school before or after school without having a direct destination or purpose (loitering) is not permitted.
- Students may not be in unauthorized areas of the building.
- Students may not be in the hallway or loitering in front of the building 10 minutes past the last bell.
- Students may only use The Noble Academy's designated stairwell.
- A parent or guardian must sign students into school if they arrive after 9:30am.
- If students participate in a school sponsored event on/off campus, they must wear a TNA-issued shirt (e.g. Gym shirt, Core Value T-Shirt, advisory T-shirt, etc.).
- Community service forms are due the Wednesday following the service and will only be accepted if complete and accurate.

Please Note: Teachers assign homework every night. If a student is absent, the onus is on the student to contact the teacher to get the homework. The protocol for receiving makeup work is that the student contacts the teacher directly either by email or upon return.
